Site Supervision Safety Training Scheme Refresher (SSSTS -R)

The Site Supervision Safety Training Scheme – Refresher (SSSTS-R) course is for candidates who have previously passed the full Site Supervision Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS) course or subsequent refresher course and can provide proof of attendance.

* You must complete this SSSTS refresher before your certificate expires or you will need to re-take the full course.

This refresher brings your health and safety knowledge up to date, as well as giving you a thorough overview of the legislative changes and their impact in the workplace. It builds on the material in the original course covering a wide range of topics as suggested below.

The SSSTS course is endorsed by Build UK as the standard training for all construction supervisors.

Topics covered:

- ✓ How health and safety law is structured
- ✓ How the supervisory role fits in with the manager's role in controlling the site safely
- ✓ Understanding the need for method statements
- ✓ Construction Site Health, Safety and Welfare
- ✓ Communication routes within site activity
- ✓ Behavioural safety
- ✓ Supervision of occupational health.

Course information:

Entry requirements:

The Site Supervision Safety Training Scheme – Refresher (SSSTS-R) course is for candidates who have previously passed the full Site Supervision Safety Training Scheme (SSSTS) course or subsequent refresher course and can provide proof of attendance. Candidates must be competent in English at site supervisor level. Please contact us if you have any concerns in this area.

You will need to provide Photographic ID on the first day of the course, such as a copy of your passport or driving licence.

Assessment and exams:

This is a highly interactive course delivered by means of case studies, classroom discussion, group work and individual/group presentations. You will be continuously assessed and required to successfully complete a question paper, made up of multiple-choice question and short written answers.

Qualifications/certification:

Upon successfully completing the course you will be awarded a CITB Site Safety Plus certificate valid for 5 years. To remain certified in this area, you will need to take a refresher course before the expiry date on your certificate, otherwise the full course will need to be retaken.
